

The foreigners' registration procedure is only for **India and Pakistan** nationals. The Registration procedure is very simple as the foreigners only need to provide their **passports and photos** before the registration officers. Registration of foreigners is done in the following offices of **Special Branch (SB)**.

- Special Branch Headquarters, Malibagh, Dhaka.
- Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport, Dhaka.
- All District Special Branch (DSB) offices.
- Benapol Land Port, Jashore.

India nationals need to get their registration if he/she has **180** days or more Visa within **14** days of their arrival in Bangladesh and Pakistan nationals need to do it within **07** days if he/she has **90** days or more Visa.

If anyone fail to get registration within due dates then they need to pay extra fees through designated bank account.

Fees for Late Registration

Indian	15 th -21 st day after arrival	2000/- BDT

Pakistani	8 th -14 th day after arrival	2000/- BDT

If anyone loses his/her registration sheet he/she needs to pay 500/- BDT for replacement of his/her registration sheet. This amount of money is also received through designated bank account.

The foreigners' registration procedure is governed by *The Registration of Foreigners' Rules 1966*. In every immigration check point, all DSBs and SB Headquarters are providing registration services for the foreigners, i.e India and Pakistan nationals.

India nationals need to get their registration if he/she has 180 days or more Visa within 14 days of their arrival in Bangladesh and Pakistan nationals need to do it within 07 days if he/she has 90 days or more Visa.
